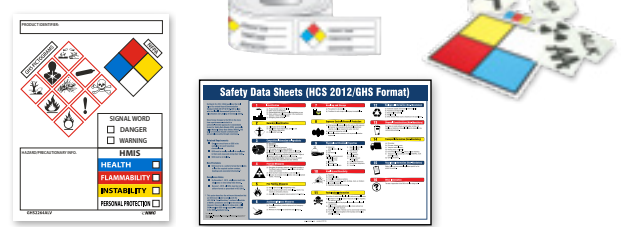

2,888 violations for Hazard Communication (29 CFR 1910.1200)



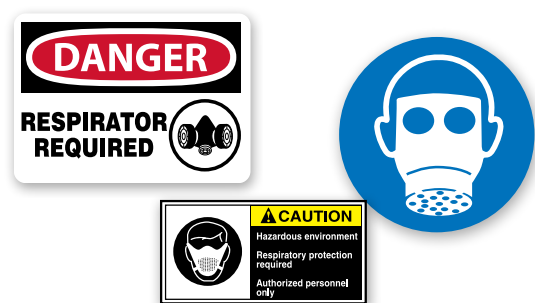
